The Wardens and Vestry of St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Portland, Maine are seeking to call a half-time Priest In Charge for an initial term of three years, which term may be extended on such terms as the Priest in Charge, the Diocese, and St. Peter's Vestry may agree in writing. Employment benefits shall be provided in accord with those of the Episcopal Diocese of Maine, to which reference is made. Aspects of the Priest In Charge's half-time work with St. Peter's will include preaching God's Word at mass on Christmas and Easter and twice monthly in the Church (or online), as circumstances may permit, as well as coordinating the work of our current Assisting Priest and that of supply priests and/or other Sunday celebrants for remaining Sundays, and attendance at Vestry and Executive Committee meetings. For two days per week, the Priest In Charge of St. Peter's will have pastoral care work, enhancement of real world and online parish presence to juggle. Flexibility to be available for weddings, funerals and participation in other parish events is also desired.
