Assessments

170100 Assessments 1.545.715

Based on the Normal Operating Income (NOI) reported by each congregation on the Parochial Report for the calendar year ending one year prior to the start of the budget year, i.e. 2024 Parochial Report NOI is used for the 2026 Assessment calculation. Each congregation will pay: 5% of the first \$10,000 of NOI reported by each congregation. All NOI in excess of \$10,000 will be multiplied by a percent sufficient so the combination of each of these steps applied to all congregations in the Diocese will raise the total funds specified in the annual Diocesan budget that are to be provided by the annual assessment upon congregations. For the budget year 2026, the remainder percentage is 15.0%.

2,500

This is the diocesan commitment to work toward justice and peace for all people and public policies.

180900 International Outreach 10,000

This is the diocesan commitment to international outreach through grants.

180950 Domestic Outreach 25,000

This is the diocesan commitment to domestic outreach through grants.

186900 Committee on Indian Relations 5,500

This line covers Committee work and scholarship funds for the Wabanaki K100 event.

186950 Portland - St. Elizabeth's Pantry 5,000

This line covers the cost of diocesan support for the Jubilee Center at St. Elizabeth's Pantry in Portland.

186920 Augusta - Bridging the Gap 5,000

This line covers the cost of diocesan support for Bridging the Gap in Augusta.

186960 Seeds of Hope Neighborhood Center 5,000

This line covers the cost of diocesan support for the Jubilee Center in Biddeford.

186970 Trinity Jubilee Center 5,000

This line covers the cost of diocesan support for Trinity Jubilee Center in Lewiston.

Faith Formation. These resources support faith formation.

182900 Youth Ministry Program/Youth Events 5,000

This line covers the cost of support for diocesan youth programs and events including middle school weekends, high school events and an event for young adults.

182920 Summer Finale 4,000

This line covers the cost of the end of summer family/youth event.

182940 Christian Ed Collaboration 500

This line covers the cost of the connecting people doing formation work.

182960 Young Adult Formation 500

This line covers the cost of support for Young Adult Formation.

182970 Adult Formation 3,000

This line covers the cost of support for Adult Formation.

184400 Education for Ministry 2,400

Education for Ministry ("EfM") is a program of theological education by extension from The School of Theology Extension Center, the University of the South, Sewanee, Tennessee. This line covers the cost of the license.

185201 Bishopswood Support 67.500

This line covers the cost of support for Camp Bishopswood.

185803 Spring Training 2,000

This line covers the cost of a Diocesan wide day program with workshops and continuing education.

185805 Clergy Formation Committee 20,000

This line covers the cost of the diocese's program for clergy continuing education.

Congregation & Clergy Support. These resources support congregations and clergy.

182600 Transition Ministry 2,000

This line covers the cost of support for congregations' search processes.

182601 Congregational Consultants

500

This line covers the costs of a trained network of consultants available to provide outside expertise and facilitation in a wide variety of congregational situations.

182602 New Clergy Mentorship Program

1.000

This line covers the costs of a program for training for priests new to a Diocese of Maine church call.

182801 On-line Giving Fees

4,500

This line covers the costs for the diocese program for on-line giving to churches and diocese-related organizations.

184000 Clergy Internships/Seminary Support

32,000

This line supports education and internships for those in the ordination process.

184100 Commission on Ministry Expense

2,500

The Commission on Ministry assists the Bishop by determining the present and future needs for ministry in the diocese, recruiting and selecting persons for Holy Orders.

184101 Deacon Formation Program

5.000

The Deacon Formation Program is a program of preparation for ordination to the Diaconate. This line covers the cost of facilitators and student expenses. Income from tuition is used to offset training expenses.

184102 Background Checks

250

This line covers the Diocese portion of individual applicant background checks.

184600 Diocesan Discernment Process

2,500

This line covers expenses related to individuals discerning their call to lay or ordained ministry.

185000 Chaplain to Retired Clergy

1,000

This line covers the expenses incurred by the Chaplains to Retired Clergy.

185800 Community of Deacons

200

This line item covers expenses related to Deacons' assignments carried out for the Bishop, for dues to the national organization and its publications, for the meetings of the Community of Deacons, and for expenses of the Archdeacon.

190109 New Initiative Grants

20,000

This line covers the costs of New Initiative grants.

190111 Stewardship and Evangelism

2,000

This line covers the cost of diocesan membership in The Episcopal Network for Stewardship.

182XXX Strategic Congregational Support

186.487

This line provides support for parishes with specific financial needs related to clergy compensation designed to bolster the distinctive ministries of Maine's smaller congregations.

180101 National Church Assessment

287,644

The assessment formula is 15.0% of 2024 diocesan income after an exemption of \$200,000 had been deducted.

180300 Provincial Synod Assessment

7,225

The Dioceses of the New England states comprise the Province of New England. Each Diocese is assessed a portion of the total Provincial program budget based on the number of communicants in good standing.

80400 Travel, General Convention (2027)

20.000

Reserve funds for the deputies from our Diocese to attend the General Convention to be held in 2027.

180750 Travel, Episcopal Youth Event (2027)

1,000

Reserve funds to assist in sending youth and adult chaperones to the Triennial Episcopal Youth Event.

190100 Diocesan Council Meetings

5,000

This account covers meeting costs and travel reimbursement for Diocesan Council members.

190110 Disciplinary Process 500

To cover travel and training costs for Maine members of the three-diocese Disciplinary Board.

190200 Other Diocesan Meetings 3,000

This account covers meeting costs and travel reimbursement for Diocesan Meetings.

190201 Standing Committee 1,500

This covers miscellaneous costs of the Committee.

190500 Convention Arrangements 25,000

Costs of setting up and running the 2026 Diocesan Convention. Cost of facilities, refreshments and meals, equipment, and printed materials are included in this line.

190600 Diocesan Audit 20,000

This account covers the cost of the annual audit of the diocese's 2025 financial statements.

Bishop, Staff & Loring House. These resources fund technology, physical plant needs and support the Bishop's office.

190802 Diocesan Communications/Web Site – Digital Administration 25,000

This line covers the cost for the diocesan website and domain services, Basecamp for project management, Zoom for online meetings, social media promotions, and live-streaming and video on demand of events.

190805 Information Technology 17,500

This line covers the cost of acquiring and maintaining the software and computer hardware systems at Loring House as well as covering the annual costs for database and accounting software and computer functions.

190910 Copyright Licenses and Fees 1,500

This line covers the user costs for materials used in online communications and worship services.

191100 Archives 10,000

This line covers costs required to safely store and catalogue diocesan and parish records, and to support occasional technical assistance from a consultant.

191800 Diocesan Use of Cathedral 35,371

This line covers the amount paid to the Cathedral Church of St. Luke to help defray the costs of diocesan use of the Cathedral.

192200 Property & Casualty Insurance 21,500

This line covers the cost of the diocesan commercial insurance package, i.e. property, liability, automobile, Directors and Officers, Worker's Compensation, Crime insurance, and other coverages.

192203 Parish Administrator's Collaborative 750

This line covers the cost of meetings of congregation administrators.

192300 Parking 3,600

This line covers the cost of parking space rental for Bishop and staff.

192301 Maintenance – Cleaning 6,000

This line covers the cost for cleaning and general maintenance of Loring House.

192303 Maintenance – Capital and Roof Reserve 100

This line reserves funds for planning the rehabilitation and remodeling of the interior of Loring House.

192304 Maintenance – Snow 3,650

This line covers the cost of snow removal and the ice treatment for walks and stairs.

192305 Maintenance – Recycling 400

This line covers the cost of recycling waste from Loring House.

192306 Maintenance – Other 3,500

This line covers the miscellaneous costs associated with maintaining the Loring House office space.

192307 Maintenance – Labor 600

This line covers the cost of installing and removing air conditioners and other seasonal equipment moves.

192500 Phone/Internet Service 12.000

This line covers the cost of diocesan office phone service, cell phone services, and internet service for the Bishop and Loring House.

192600 Postage 2,500

This line covers the cost of mail and package service for diocesan administration.

192700 Depreciation 2,400

This line covers annual depreciation of capitalized furnishings and equipment.

192701 Maintenance contracts/leases 7,500

This line covers the cost of maintenance contracts and leases for copiers, postage meter and alarm system.

192800 Bank service fees 3,000

This line covers bank-related service costs.

192900 Miscellaneous 3,500

This line covers miscellaneous expenses not covered by other expense lines.

193000 Legal Expenses 500

This line covers the cost of legal consultations not handled by the Chancellor (the Chancellor is the Bishop's Counsel) and to continue building reserve monies for unanticipated legal expenses with funds not expended for current year expenses. This line also covers travel and registration fees for the Chancellor to attend provincial and other gatherings of Diocesan Chancellors.

6560 Payroll Service Costs 36.000

This line covers the cost of processing payroll for the Diocese of Maine and is offset by the Diocesan Central Payroll Program. Fees to congregations for 2026 remain at \$4.00 per check per pay period.060468

194XXX Salaries/Housing/Benefits 967,391

See the detailed schedule for individual positions making up the Bishop and Staff budget category for the 2026 budget year. This line covers cash compensation, Social Security employer contribution (lay employees), self-employment tax reimbursement (clergy employees), the employer portion of the medical/dental/life insurance package and contracted labor.

194010 Contractors 101,950

See the detailed schedule for individual areas requiring additional staff support.

194300 Pension 119,997

This line covers the employer pension payments for Bishop and staff.

194500 Business Travel Expenses 35,000

This line covers the cost of Bishop and staff travel, lodging, meals on the road, and mileage reimbursement.

194600 Staff Continuing Ed 25,000

This line covers the cost of enabling staff to obtain continuing education and update their skills.
